Harper's Story MUSC Shawn Jenkins Children's Hospital



Halfway to term, new parents Jenna and Stephen learn their unborn daughter's diagnosis: the most severe form of a spinal cord defect, myelomeningocele spina bifida, where the spinal cord herniates from the back without the protective layers of membrane, bone and muscle that normally insulate a person's bundle of nervous tissue from the world. Accepting months of uncertainty knowing she may never walk, they place their faith in a team of MUSC Children's Hospital caregivers. Jenna comments about her now three year old daughter, "Harper has not only made a difference in our lives.. but a community of people's lives.
