Clay Court Update

The court maintenance staff has been able to hand roll the majority of the clay courts on the north side only [court side closest to the bridge]. This has allowed us to scratch these areas to let air into the surface of the court which in turn hardens the court. We have been unable to touch the south side of the courts due to the softness in these areas. We received rain Thursday night with more rain in the forecast for Friday. As mentioned in the previous update the rain could help the situation. We will continue to work on the courts this weekend in hopes of bringing a few clay courts back on line early next week. Our goal is to insure that the clay courts are returned to mint condition and are safe to play on with all line tapes firmly in place. Thank you once again for your patience.
